

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS INVITATION TO BID

Pavement Rehab & Sewer Replacement Project

Sealed bids will be accepted until **2:00 pm on Wednesday, July 8, 2015**. Bids submitted after this time will not be accepted. Address bids to Alan McCall at City of Newberg, Engineering Services Department, P.O. Box 970, 414 E. First Street, Newberg, Oregon 97132. At the same time bids will be opened and publicly read aloud at 2:00 pm.

This project is divided into two parts: 1) **Sewer Restoration** which includes replacing 1325' of 8" mainline 6' deep with 400' of 4" laterals in place of current degraded sewer line, and removing / installing catch basins. 2) **Pavement Restoration** which includes grind and inlay at four locations; North Main for about 550', East half of South Main for about 380', South Meridian for about 280', and North and South Elliott for about 1600', involving removal and replacement of traffic loops, installing new ADA ramps and curb, and restoration of pavement markings. Each part of the project has its own mobilization, and traffic control for the bid schedule. The City reserves the right to increase, decrease, or completely eliminate quantities as set forth in the Bid Schedule of Prices.

In order to be eligible for award of City of Newberg construction contracts, the bidders must provide documentation of their qualified and proven experience in the following work classifications; Asphalt Paving, Aggregate Base, Temporary Traffic Control, Concrete Flatwork, and Sewer construction. Bidders are required to complete the "Contractor's Prequalification Application Form" in order to be awarded. This form shall be submitted no later than 5 business days for approval prior to the bid opening. The City will reject bids from bidders who are not prequalified or showing the necessary qualifications for this project.

This is a public works project subject to BOLI prevailing wage rates required by ORS 279C.800-870. By signing the bid, the bidder agrees to comply with those provisions which state that workers on public works projects are to be paid not less than the current prevailing rate of wage for Region 3 (see BOLI website at <http://www.oregon.gov/BOLI>.) In addition, all bidders shall be compliant with all tax laws and the successful bidder shall carry Workers' Compensation and Unemployment Insurance in accordance with ORS 656.001 through 656.794. No bid for a construction contract shall be considered unless the bidder is registered with the Construction Contractors Board as required by ORS 701.035 to 701.055.

Each bid must be submitted on the prescribed form completely filled out and signed, in a sealed envelope, clearly marked that it is a bid, and have the bidder's name and the project title on the outside of the envelope. Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to the City of Newberg, Oregon, in an amount of not less than ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid submitted. Each bid must also be accompanied by a fully executed Non-Collusion Affidavit and within two hours after bid opening the First-Tier Disclosure Form. Failure to provide these documents will result in disqualification of the bid.

The City of Newberg reserves the right to reject any bid not in compliance with all prescribed public bidding procedures and requirements and may reject for good cause any or all bids on a finding of the City that it is in the public interest to do so; and to accept the bid which is in the best interest of the City. No bidder may withdraw their bid for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after the date set for opening. No prebid meeting is scheduled for this project.
